### CITY OF UNION GAP REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) ENGINEERING SERVICES

PROPOSAL TITLE: Regional Beltway Connector Project

PROPOSAL DUE DATE: June 2, 2016

The City of Union Gap, Washington ("City") is soliciting proposals from consulting firms with expertise in Civil and Structural Engineering Design. This agreement will be for approximately 18 months in duration with the option for the City to extend it for additional time and money if necessary. Consultants will be considered for the following project. The City reserves the right to amend terms of this "Request for Proposal" (RFP) to circulate various addenda, or to withdraw the RFP at any time, regardless of how much time and effort consultants have spent on their responses.

### **Project Description**

The work to be performed by the CONSULTANT consists of providing professional services to prepare Plan, Specifications and Estimate (PS&E) for the New Regional Beltway Connector Project. The proposed new Beltway connector will establish a federally designated arterial from Main Street near the Interstate 82 and US 97 Interchange (South Union Gap Interchange) to the existing Union Gap and Yakima County east/west arterial, Ahtanum Road. This new Beltway arterial will provide a limited access route through currently undeveloped commercial and industrial property in Union Gap to Ahtanum Road.

The proposed new Beltway will provide an alternative for motorist traveling through Union Gap to or from Interstate 82 (I-82) or US 97. Currently, vehicles must use the heavily travailed Main Street and Valley Mall Boulevard arterials, through the City's active commercial districts, in order to connect to Ahtanum Road. The new Beltway will particularly reduce freight/truck traffic on Main Street and the eastern end of Ahtanum Road. This is extremely important as the current travel route passes through an existing elementary school zone on Ahtanum Road.

The primary purpose of the regional Beltway connector is to efficiently move traffic and freight between the South Union Gap Interchange and Ahtanum Road thereby improving travel to and from the western areas of Union Gap and the Upper Yakima Valley.

To achieve this primary goal, the Beltway must connect to the I-82/US 97 Interchange via an above grade structure crossing over the existing BNSF tracks. It is recommended to be a limited access four-lane arterial with no driveways and few intersecting roads. Access to properties adjacent to the Beltway will require use of interior roadway systems that connect to the arterial at controlled intersections. Discussions with adjacent property owners regarding potential future development identified roundabouts as being the preferred intersection design. Roadway cross sections may also include a separate 12 foot wide joint bicycle/pedestrian pathway and/or an 8 foot wide sidewalk.

This project consists of a two step approach ("agreement"). The first agreement, preliminary engineering services up to 30%. The successful firm shall develop the project engineering to a

preliminary state that provides a starting point for environmental resource agency permitting; starts BNSF on the buy-in process; and provides a cost-certain construction estimate. Deliverables from this step include 30% Plan, Elevation and Typical Section drawings for the bridge and plan, grade and typical section drawings for the roadway. Also included in this step would be a geotechnical investigation report, utility conflict report, determination of R/W needs, Bridge Type Size and Location report and 30% Level Construction Cost Estimate.

The second agreement would be to complete the final design. This step concludes with PS& E that is ready to include in an advertisement for contractor bid. Deliverables from this step include plans and construction Specifications, final approval of the environmental documents, BNSF crossing permit, R/W plan preparation, bridge load rating & bridge inventory documents in accordance with WSDOT, NBIS and AASHTO Manuals, latest editions. At the discretion of the City, this final design step may be a contract modification to the 30% PE contract or a new RFP.

The City also reserves the right to retain the services of the successful firm(s) for any subsequent phases (R/W, CN) associated with this/these project(s).

Specific project cost estimates shall not be requested until a consultant has been selected.
