

CITY OF UNION GAP, WA
POLICE OFFICER - LATERAL

The City of Union Gap is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Police Officer – Lateral. Applicants must be a United States citizen, able to read and write the English language, have a minimum of a high school diploma or GED, and be 21 years of age at the time of appointment. Must possess or be able to obtain by the time of hire a valid Washington State Driver's License without suspension or revocation in the State. Must be in good health, of good moral character, have a good credit rating, and possess a good personality, judgment, and aptitude. Height and weight must be proportionate, must be physically fit and capable of arduous duty. Applicants must have a minimum of twenty-four (24) months of full time paid service as a sworn police officer in a civilian governmental jurisdiction in the past 5 years prior to the application, and be certified by the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission as a Police Officer, or have the ability to successfully complete the State Basic Training Equivalency Test within 1 year after employment. Felony convictions and disqualifying criminal histories within the past 7 years are not allowed. Salary ranges from \$4,412 to \$5,414 per month, DOQ, plus benefits.
