



The Union Gap Police Department is currently taking applications for the position of Reserve Police Officer.

The department is recruiting people who are over the age of 21, have a high school diploma or a GED equivalent, have a good driving record and have no criminal misdemeanor or felony convictions. Must be able to read, speak and write the English language and be a US Citizen.

Candidates for the reserve program must pass a thorough background investigation, including a polygraph and Psychological examination.

The closing date for applications is November 9, 2015.

Those who are accepted will undergo a 280 hour Reserve Academy in January 2016. Classes are two nights a week (Tuesday and Thursday) and Saturday.
