



WATER SERVICE - REQUIREMENTS

All Property Owners and / or Contractors must contact the Director of Public Works regarding water service installation. Please check all that apply:

Mandatory Requirements:

If working within City Right-of-Way, all adjacent Property Owners must be notified of the project *prior* to work commencing.

Property owners are required to contact the <u>Utility Notification Center: Call Before You Dig</u> of their intent to dig. By phone dial 8-1-1 or go on-line to <u>https://www.washington811.com/</u>.

Water Service Connection:

- ✓ City will install city-side water service (some exceptions pertain).
- ✓ Property owners are responsible for all work required on the owner's property.
- ✓ Existing private wells shall be decommissioned, per the WA State Department of Ecology guidelines.
- ✓ Transfer exempt water rights to the City of Union Gap.
- ✓ The City pays all associated fees for the filing and decommissioning of the existing private well.
- ✓ Property owners must obtain a plumbing permit (approximately \$50) from the City's Community Development department.
- * Some exceptions pertain; additional fees may apply to certain areas
- ** To be reviewed and determined by the Director of Public Works
- E.R.U. Equivalent Residential Unit

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
